**“A Tribute to Veterans”** Gary Kissinger, retired veteran, will give a presentation which will include military recruiting posters, music and video clips from World War I through the Gulf Wars. He will conclude his presentation by showing the results of the work done by the American Battlefields Monument Commission.

#### **November 14**

**“Rookie Cop”** Richard Rosenthal, former NYPD officer and author will tell about his initial assignment as an undercover agent assigned to gather intelligence from the militant Jewish Defense League. In addition to dealing with the League's violent actions with weapons and bombs, there was the management of the stress of undercover work.
